About Scottish Rowing

Scottish Rowing is the Governing Body for rowing in Scotland. Our vision is a successful and thriving rowing community and our mission is to support and empower people in Scotland to enjoy rowing and achieve their potential.

Since 2022, Scottish Rowing has gone through an exciting period of significant change with the introduction of a new Olympic discipline, the expansion of the performance programme and a specific focus on extending the reach of the sport into non-traditional rowing communities. We will undoubtably see the Scotland Rowing Team grow even stronger as a result of these changes and we are now recruiting an Independent Performance Advisor to sit withing the Performance Advisory Group to guide the future generations of international athletes.

Scottish Rowing currently employs a team of 11 staff, supported by an ambitious Board and key volunteers with the organisation based at the Scottish Rowing Centre – its own dedicated training facility and office space at Strathclyde Country Park, near Motherwell.

This will be a unique and exciting opportunity to help shape the future of one of Scotland's leading Olympic sports.



Background Information

The Scottish Rowing Performance Advisory Group (PAG) aims to support and challenge the strategic direction of Scottish Rowing's Performance Pathway operations with the aim of enabling more of Scotland's rowers to compete successfully on the world stage.

Responsibilities of Performance Advisory Group

- To understand the strategic aims and objectives of the Scottish Rowing Performance Pathway team. Including the Annual Targets and Long-Term Outcomes as agreed with **sport**scotland.
- To act at all times in the best interest of the Scottish Rowing Performance Pathway, Scotland Rowing Team, and where appropriate, GB Rowing Team.
- To attend periodic meetings of the Performance Advisory Group (~3 per year).
- To work closely with the Scottish Rowing Performance Pathway team through the Head of Performance.
- To offer expertise and advice on the strategy and advancement of the Scottish Rowing Performance Pathway.
- To advise on the recruitment of athletes into the Scottish Rowing Performance Programme.
- To advise on the formation and amendment of Selection Policies for Scottish Rowing (such as the Scotland Rowing Team for Home International Rowing and Commonwealth Rowing Association events).
- To ratify Team Selections by the Selection Panel's for the Scotland Rowing Teams, ensuring that due process is followed as per the relevant Selection Policy.
- To assist in the recruitment of Performance Pathway staff and further members of the Performance Advisory Group, where appropriate.
- To attend Scottish Rowing Performance Pathway and Scotland Rowing Team activity, as appropriate.
- Be a member of the PVG Scheme for Scottish Rowing.

Responsibilities of the Independent Performance Advisor

The role of the Independent Performance Advisor(s) will be to provide experience and insight from outwith rowing, to ensure the group and it's members are working to best practice, and operating in a clear and unbiased way.

In addition to the general duties and responsibilities of the Performance Advisory Group, the Independent Performance Advisor(s) will:

- Act as an 'External Selector' for the Selection Panels of the Scotland Rowing Team, providing unbiased perspective on decision making.
- Offer independent advice and expertise regarding the strategic and operational advancement of the Performance Pathway and Scotland Rowing Team.
- Play a role in developing a network of practice outwith rowing for the advancement of the Scottish Rowing Performance Pathway.

Applicants for the position of Independent Performance Advisor should meet the following person specifications:

Knowledge	 A wide knowledge of high-performance sport outside of rowing (essential) and high-performance environments and culture (desirable). An understanding of Performance Pathway development outside of rowing (desired).
Skills & Abilities	 Ability to understand and check/challenge performance data and selection processes (essential). Ability to build strong, transparent relationships with other PAG members and key stakeholders (essential). Confidence to contribute to meetings/discussions on topics outside of your primary sport (essential).
Experience	 Experience of working within a high-performance environment (essential) in sport (desirable). Experience of being part of a Selection Panel and selection processes (essential). Experience of working on a Performance Advisory Group/Committee (or similar) in another sport (desired).
