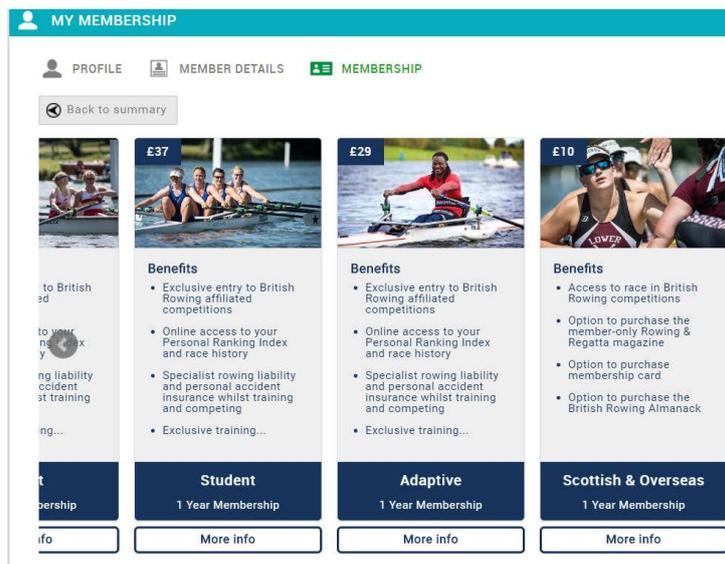

With the launch of their new membership system, British Rowing have changed the requirements for Scottish Rowing licence holders competing in England and Wales. Scottish Rowing licence holders will now need to individually register on British Rowing's membership system. Scottish Licences on the British Rowing Membership system are free of charge (a refund is added on payment screen). **A photograph is required before purchasing a licence.** Clubs will no longer be able to register rowers within British Rowing Online Entry. A valid Scottish licence purchased through the Scottish Rowing Membership system (<https://scottishrowing.azolve.com>) is still required to compete for a Scottish club in England and Wales.

The step by step guide below details how to complete this registration process:

1. Register (or log in to an existing account) at <https://britishrowing.azolve.com/>
2. Click the Membership link at the top of the screen
3. Select Race from the British Rowing Categories
4. Select Scottish & Overseas from the list of licence categories



5. Scroll down and fill in your Primary club (Scottish clubs are available)
6. You must add a photo at this point (please read the guidelines)
7. Using the drop-down options please answer the questions about your competition history. This is optional but will help regatta organisers to place you in the correct category in competitions.

- Click the confirmation statements at the bottom and then click Finish
- A window will pop up saying your cart has been updated and asking if you want to proceed to checkout. Click Yes, Pay now. - You will see an invoice for your licence. It will show the cost as £10 but will show a refund of £10 to make the total payable £0 as Scottish based rowers do not need to pay to compete in events in England and Wales. This discount is worked out as a result of your address and postcode so you must have filled this in correctly.
- Click Complete Order – You should not be asked for any payment details unless you have added a paid licence as well.
